Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.74 dated 07.07.2021, under Sections 376 D(A), 451 IPC and Section 6 POCSO Act and (Section 4 POCSO Act added later on), registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala.

Vide order dated 15.11.2022, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 7 days and on their doing so, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and join the proceedings.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 15.11.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
