ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to stop the repeated enquiries qua FIR No.77 dated 26.09.2022, under Sections 447, 427, 506, 511, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sudhar Ludhiana Rural, Distt. Ludhiana alongwith further prayer to transfer the investigation of the case out of Ludhiana Rural as respondent No.2 is personally interested in the litigation.

2. Counsel for the State submits that the concerned SSP-respondent No.2 has been transferred as such second prayer of the petitioner has become infructuous. As far as multiple enquires are concerned, State counsel submits that investigation is going on.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that once the concerned SSP has been transferred as such he has no grudge in this regard.

4. Given above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police to ensure the completion of investigation on or before 30.09.2023. Liberty reserved to the petitioner to come to avail appropriate remedy available to him in accordance with law including filing fresh petition.
