DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the order dated 23.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) whereby bail bonds of the petitioner were forfeited and the arrest warrant has been issued against the petitioner and further to allow the petitioner to continue to appear before the trial Court in FIR No. 93 dated 01.05.2019 under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Sadar Ratia, District Fatehabd.

Learned State counsel pointed out that petitioner on 24.01.2023 concealed the material fact from this Court as he has mentioned only 2 FIR pending against him but as per instructions, 14 other cases are pending against the present petitioner and the details of the same have not been mentioned in the present petition. Further, this petition has been filed by some other counsel and on 24.01.2023, Mr. Amit Singla, Advocate had put in appearance on behalf of petitioner and filed his power of attorney.

Faced with the submission made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of his power of attorney.

No ground is made out for the same.

Present petition is dismissed with costs amounting of Rs. 30,000/- to be paid in *Punjab & Haryana High Court Employees Welfare Association Fund* by the petitioner.

The trial Court is directed to ensure the compliance of this order before entertaining the application for bail by the petitioner.
