Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.149 dated 3.8.2022 registered under Sections 323, 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana.

The allegations in nutshell are that co-accused Gagandeep @ Mor caused firearm injury to Rakesh brother-in-law of the complainant while the present petitioner and other persons caught hold said Rakesh and one Rana. During investigation of the case, main accused/Gagandeep @ Mor was arrested.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the order of interim bail dated 14.11.2022.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh submits

that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and

that main accused Gagandeep @ Mor is arrested and recovery of firearm is already effected from said Gagandeep @ Mor and that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
