MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)

By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have sought the quashing of the FIR bearing No.160 dated 05.05.2023 registered at Police Station Arya Nagar, Rohtak, District Rohtak, under Sections 498-A, 323, 406 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from L/ASI Bindu Bala from the above-referred Police Station, he informs the Court that the investigation in the criminal case under reference is still continuing and thus, the Challan is yet to be presented in the Competent Court.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners seek permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioners would file a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in this petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.
4. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.
5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
