After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the arguments at an appropriate stage before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is resident of Village and Post Office Barahamadpur Jariyari and is aged about 59 years. His son Jitender Mishra is already facing trial before the trial Court. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner may kindly be granted exemption from personal appearance before the trial Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

The petitioner is at liberty to move an application for exemption from personal appearance before the trial Court and, in case, any such application is filed by the petitioner, it shall be considered sympathetically by the trial Court, in accordance with law. Trial Court shall also be at liberty to impose such conditions, as it may deem fit and proper.
