Present application has been filed for placing on record the copy of order dated 28.08.2003, report No.113 of 22.12.2013 in the Roznamcha of Patwari, copy of the application dated 14.08.2021 made to FC (Revenue) Punjab, Chandigarh, copy of application dated 26.07.2022 made to Naib Tehsildar/Assistant Collector, Majri and the letter dated 02.02.2021 written by the Naib Tehsildar Majri to Patwari Circle as Annexures P-7 to P-11.

For the reasons recorded in the application, documents as Annexures P-7 to P-11 are ordered to be taken on record.

Application stands allowed.

Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents for deleting the remarks in the Jamabandi for the year 2013-

2014 relating to the land measuring 174 bigha 8 biswa comprising in Khata No.280/253, Khasra Nos.1 (51-13 Bigha), 2 (96-13 Bigha), 3/1 (25-0 Bigha), 96/2 (1-1) and 99/2 (01) situated within the revenue estate of village Bharonjian, District SAS Nagar whereby the impugned entry/remarks has been made in the Jamabandi. Further prayer has been made for staying the operation of impugned order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have already filed application dated 26.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) before the Naib Tehsildar/Assistant Collector, Majri, Tehsil Kharar but no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Learned State counsel fairly submits that the application allegedly filed by the petitioner is not traceable. She further submits that if any representation is filed by the petitioners, the same would be decided keeping in view the overall facts and circumstances of the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be allowed to file a fresh representation before respondent No.2, who would decide the same in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation before respondent No.2 within a week from today. In case any such representation

is filed by the petitioners within a week from today, then respondent No.2-Collector-cum-Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of its receipt.
