MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0189, dated 24.08.2022, registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

2. Vide order dated 24.07.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.07.2023, granting

interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
