This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the member schools of the petitioner trust to open their schools during the vacation period except on the dates of festivals in terms of provisions of Haryana Education Rules, 2003 (Annexure P-3) and CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws (Annexure P-4) which provides for minimum teaching hours to be followed for every academic session.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel are *ad idem* that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
