Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to pass orders for making necessary arrangement for the smooth running of Shree Ganesh Mahotasav.

The apprehension expressed by the petitioner was on account of the allegations/complaint submitted by one Jatinder Mahindroo.

Apparently, the present writ petition has been filed on the basis of apprehensions and conjectures and no substantive cause of action has arisen. Even otherwise, the dispute would have been private in nature between the petitioner and said Jatinder Mahindroo.

Further, it has been informed, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana, by the learned State counsel who is on advance notice, that the parties have already entered into a settlement amongst themselves.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition, at this stage, so as to 20978take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law if the cause of action still survives and if so advised.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberties as aforesaid.
