Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0058 dated 31.01.2022 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 363, 366-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 84 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (later Sections 328 IPC, 376(2)(n) of IPC, 1860 and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 added) at Police Station Sonipat Sadar, District Sonipat.

Vide order dated 28.10.2022, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court within 10 days and on his appearance, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 28.10.2022, the petitioner has appeared

before the trial Court on 02.11.2022 and has been granted interim bail. He therefore, prays that the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.10.2022 may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner.

In light of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.10.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C..
