1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for setting aside of order dated 18.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, whereby an application moved under Section 205 Cr.P.C., at the instance of petitioner, seeking exemption from personal appearance, stood dismissed.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition, however, prays for grant of liberty to approach the Trial Court for seeking exemption from personal appearance for date specific.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of being not pressed. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application seeking exemption from his personal appearance for the specific date with specific reason before the Trial Court, which shall be considered on merits.
