Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case bearing FIR No.27 dated 25.03.2022 under Sections 379/427 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar, Punjab (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 26.10.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.10.2022, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.10.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
