The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* directing the respondents to issue/re-issue passport to the petitioner.

Mr. Ankur Sharma, Advocate appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has submitted that the application which was filed by the petitioner for grant of passport has already been closed and in case the petitioner files a fresh application for grant of passport in accordance with law, the same shall be processed and finalized expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent-Passport Authorities, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

Needless to say that it is expected that the Passport Authorities will honour their statement which is given to the Court that in case the fresh application is filed, the same will be finalized expeditiously.
