1. Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the case bearing FIR No.111 dated 08.10.2022, under Sections 323/324/148/149/120-B/320 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Jagdish Raj, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Phillaur, District Jalandhar (Rural) on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the offence under Sections 120-B/148/149 IPC have been deleted and the offence under Sections 326 & 307 IPC have been added subsequent to the registration of the FIR. Respondent No.5 has been arrested and after his police remand, he has been remanded to judicial custody. A datar has been recovered from him and the same has been sent to the FSL and the report is awaited. Furthermore, respondent Nos.6 to 9 have been found to be innocent during the course of investigation. On conclusion of the investigation, challan has been presented in the Court.
