1. The petitioner herein is cousin of judgment debtor. His objection petition has been dismissed by the Executing Court. The petitioner claims to be the co-owner of the house, which has been attached. A reading of the impugned order proves that the similar objection petitions were filed by the judgment debtor Sh. Paviter Singh. The same was dismissed on 02.08.2018. Moreover, the petitioner has not produced any material to prove that he is one of the co-owner apart from a copy of the jamabandi, which is not a document of title.

2. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.

3. Dismissed accordingly.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
