The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0132 dated 14.08.2023 registered under Sections 353, 186, 323, 324, 332, 506, 149, 325 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Division 2, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 20.09.2023, passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In compliance of order dated 20.09.2023, status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Centra), Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State in Court today and the same is taken on record. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 20.09.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
