TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA J. (ORAL):

This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant 1st and 2nd ACP to the petitioner and treat her absent period as duty period. Further, the respondents be directed to grant arrears of salary alongwith interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to decide her pending representation dated 18.5.2023 (Annexure P-3) in a specified period after affording personal hearing to her.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ravinder Singh Budhwar, Addl. AG, Haryana, appearing on advance notice, submits that the pending representation dated 18.5.2023 shall be decided by respondent no.2 expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2/Director

General, Elementary Education, Haryana, to consider and decide the pending representation of the petitioner dated 18.5.2023, after affording personal hearing to her and by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. If the petitioner is found entitled the benefits claimed, the same shall be released to her within a period of six weeks therefrom.
