DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (Oral)

By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.401 dated 27.07.2023 registered under Section 22(c) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad (Section 27-A of the NDPS Act added later on).

Status report filed by way of affidavit of Shri Kulwanjt Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad has already been received through Registry. Copy supplied.

As per allegations, 3000 tablets containing the salt of Alprazolam weighing 529 grams were recovered from the gear box of a car which was being driven by co-accused Chander Pal. It is alleged that said co-accused Chander Pal nominated the petitioner to be the supplier.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated; that no recovery was effected from him; that

petitioner has no criminal antecedents; and that the trial may take long time to conclude, so he be allowed bail.

Learned State Counsel concedes the fact that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner; he has no criminal antecedents and that the petitioner has been nominated only on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by co-accused Chander Pal. Learned State Counsel further submits that petitioner is in custody for more than four months.

Having regard to the afore-said facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
