Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment by way of transfer against the vacant post in the District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* contends that vide advertisement No.02/2012 dated 08.11.2012, 8763 posts of Primary Teachers (PRT), known as Junior Basic Training (JBT) Teacher, for District Cadre except District Mewat under Category No.1, were published by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board, Panchkula; that the petitioner, being eligible, had applied in General Category and was selected on the post; that upon selection, District Faridabad was allocated to the petitioner vide appointment letter dated 13.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) and she joined as such on 14.06.2017 (Annexure P-5); that since her posting in District Faridabad, the petitioner has been working there as such and that as per the condition in the advertisement, the petitioner had given six options, but instead of giving

the District of her choice, District Faridabad was allocated to her temporarily in June-2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that on 30.05.2018, the petitioner was posted in Govt. Girls Primary School No.2, Sirsa, against vacant post on deputation, and after expiry of deputation period, no further extension was granted, despite the fact that the posts were lying vacant in District Sirsa; that vide order dated 15.10.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner is still continuing on deputation at Govt. Girls Primary School No.2, Sirsa and that the case of the petitioner is covered by the order dated 27.10.2022 passed by a Coordinate Bench in CWP-5942-2019 titled as ‘Asha Vs. State of Haryana and others’ and prays that the present petition be disposed of in the same terms.

Learned State counsel submits that the transfer drive is to be taken place within next two months.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the paper-book.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of order dated 27.10.2022 passed in CWP-5942-2019 titled as ‘Asha Vs. State of Haryana and others’.

The petitioner shall participate in the next transfer drive for appropriate posting and till then, she shall continue to work on deputation at Govt. Girls Primary School No.2, Sirsa.
