1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 27.05.2022 (Annexure P-2) vide which, the petitioner has been prematurely retired w.e.f. 31.05.2022.
