MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.49 dated 16.07.2023, under Sections 323, 325, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 452, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Rural).

(2) Above FIR was registered on the basis of statement made by complainant-Kulwinder Singh with the allegations that on 16.07.2023 at around 8:30 PM, petitioners along with other co-accused forcibly entered in his Shop holding Iron Rods as well as other weapons and inflicted injuries to the petitioners and his wife.

(3) This Court, vide order dated 21.09.2023, granted interim bail to the petitioners and which reads as under:-

“Contends inter-alia that all the injuries are stated to be simple in nature.

Notice of motion for 09.11.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioners shall join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail, till the next date of hearing, on furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners shall also abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

(4) Learned State Counsel, on instructions, submits that petitioners have joined investigation and as on today, their custodial interrogation is not required.

(5) In view of above, interim order dated 21.09.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

(6) It is also made clear that petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

(7) The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case; rather confined only to decide the present bail matter.

(8) Disposed off accordingly.

(9) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
