The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to not to harass the petitioners unnecessarily and if the police wants to call the petitioners, then they may be served with proper notice.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that it is a case where son of petitioner No.1 is an accused in an FIR under Section 302 IPC and he was also declared as a proclaimed offender and petitioners No.1 and 2 are parents of the aforesaid accused person whereas petitioner No.3 is the brother. He submitted that all the three petitioners are totally unaware of the whereabouts of the aforesaid accused and he is a proclaimed offender but the police is continuously harassing and raiding the house of the petitioners without any justifiable reason in order to know the whereabouts

of accused. He submitted that repeatedly the petitioners have been harassed by the police and therefore, necessary directions may be issued in this regard.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, learned Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. He has stated that he has received an advance copy of the present petition and has also sought instructions. He submitted that the petitioners have not been harassed by the police as alleged by the learned counsel for the petitioners. In case any information is required from the petitioners, then due course of law will be followed by issuance of appropriate notice and in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the statement made by the learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same
