1. The limited relief pressed in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is to decide the appeal (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner which is stated to be pending before the respondent No.2-Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula. The appeal is directed against the order dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-14) passed by the Estate Officer-II, HSVP.

2. It is the case of the petitioner that the appeal was filed in November, 2022 and is still pending consideration and not even a single hearing in the same has taken place.

3. Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate for HSVP, in view of having advance copies, has taken due instructions and submits that there is delay also in filing the appeal and an application for condonation of delay has also been filed and now, the matter has been entrusted to the Administrator, Gurugram, who is not a party. He, however, submits that the said authority shall make efforts to decide the appeal expeditiously preferably within a period of 6

weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

4. Keeping in view the above assurance given, we dispose of the writ petition binding down the said authority to the undertaken given by the counsel.
