AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellant on the previous date of hearing had agreed that, if a sum of Rs.6,50,000/- is given over and above the amount already paid by MACT, they will be satisfied and ready to compromise the matter. Today, the matter has been discussed in detail with the counsel and representative of respondent No.2-Insurance company.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has agreed to pay only Rs.4,00,000/- and the same has been accepted by the appellant as well as by his counsel. The learned counsel for respondent No.2 seeks two days' time to get necessary approval from the Insurance company.

On his request, adjourned to 03.08.2023.”

Mr. L. S. Sidhu, Advocate alongwith appellant-Harvinder Singh were present. They signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.4,00,000/-(Rupees Four Lakhs Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount will be paid to appellant-Harvinder Singh.

Mr. Nitin Gupta, Advocate and representative for respondent No.2-

Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the

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proposal made by the counsel for the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.4,00,000/-(Rupees Four Lakhs Only) favouring appellant-Harvinder Singh s/o Teja Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 25.09.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
