1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside notice dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) issued under Section 13(2) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (SARFAESI Act), 2002 Act.

2. Learned counsel for respondent-Bank submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as petitioners' account has been settled and closed. No due certificate has also been issued to the petitioners on 26.09.2023.

3. Perusal of the file reveals that none had appeared on behalf of petitioners on the last date of hearing as Bar Association of this High Court had decided to suspend work as per resolution dated 25.09.2023. Today again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

4. Be that as it may, we find no justification for continuance of
