The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking early disposal of trial which is pending before JMIC, Barnala in FIR No.35 dated 15.06.2013 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 498A and 406 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Women Cell, Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that trial is pending since 2013 which is causing harassment to entire family. The petitioner is not seeking adjournment, however, trial is going at very low pace, resultantly till date only 5 witnesses have been examined out of 11.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjeet Singh submits that there are total 11 witnesses and 10 have already been examined.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel no order is warranted and this court is sanguine of the fact that Trial Court would adjudicate the trial expeditiously as matter is pending since 2013.
