The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for setting aside the order dated 3.9.2022 (Annexure P-2) whereby the bail order of the petitioner was cancelled in FIR No.107 dated 27.12.2019 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, Amristar.

On 29.10.2022 the following order was passed:-

“ *The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for setting aside the order dated 03.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) whereby the bail order of the petitioner was cancelled in FIR No.107 dated 27.12.2019 under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, Amritsar.*

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had noted the wrong date, therefore, he was unable to appear before the Trial Court on 03.09.2022, on which date the impugned order was passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 06.03.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.10,000/- as costs with the Guru Ravidas Sabha, PGI, Sector 12, Chandigarh and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.”

The Counsel for the petitioner submits that in furtherance of the aforementioned order the petitioner surrendered before the Judge, Special Court, Amritsar on 3.11.2022 and has been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial except for a sufficient cause.
