Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.457 dated 21.07.2015 under Section 420 IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471, 365, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 25/27/59 of the Arms Act added later on) pertaining to Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat on the basis of compromise.

As per the report received from learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samalkha in compliance of order dated 02.11.2022 of this Court, only four out of five accused have got their statements recorded with respect to the compromise arrived at with the complainant. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class has reported that no compromise has been arrived at with accused petitioner No.5 Ratan Singh alias Ratna.

In the circumstances, when this Court was not inclined to quash the FIR in question in view of the report received from the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samalkha, a prayer for withdrawal of the instant petition was made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
