On last date of hearing, following order was passed by this
Court:

*“Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.44,
dated 04.07.2023, under Sections 307, 353, 186, 341, 506 and 34 of
IPC, registered at Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that FIR has
been lodged on the statement of one police official, ASI Lachman
Singh, who had gone to get the house of petitioners vacated. It is two
petitioners, who were caused injuries by the complainant regarding
which MLRs are Annexures P-2 and P-3.*

*Learned counsel further contends that complainant allegedly
suffered some injuries, all of which are simple as is evident from
Annexure P-4 and that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in
this case.*

*Notice of motion.
Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of*

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respondent-State. Copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.
Let status report be filed on 20.10.2023.”

Today status report has not been filed. However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, concedes the fact that all the injuries on the person of complainant- ASI Lachman Singh was opined to be simple in nature, which fact is even otherwise evident from the medical opinion as placed on record by the petitioner.

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 03 months and 27 days with no criminal antecedents.

Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioners are admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
