Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Sunita from Police Station Women, NIT Faridabad, he informs the Court that the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.243 dated 01.11.2022 registered at the afore-referred Police Station, under Sections 498A, 406, 506, 323, 376, 377 and 354A read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, has already been decided by the concerned trial Court vide the judgment dated 12.09.2023 and the accused therein have been acquitted.
