DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the service benefits/retiral benefits including gratuity, Provident Fund, leave encashment, Ex-gratia, Group Personal Accident Insurance amount and other admissible benefits under the revised pay scales along with interest @ 18% per annum on account of delayed release with regard to service rendered by late Sh. Vikas working as Class-IV Sewerman i.e., deceased husband of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.3 submits that on account of death of her husband the petitioner has been given compassionate appointment as well as retiral benefits including Gratuity, Provident Fund, Leave encashment, Ex-gratia by the respondent No.3, which are in process and the same shall be released within two months. As far as the amount qua Group Personal Accident Insurance amount and other admissible benefits are concerned, as per the

Insurance Policy, the respondent No.3 has forwarded the claim of the petitioner to the Insurance Company.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the respondent No.3, nothing remains to be adjudicated and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
