It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 Ujjagar Singh had a brother named Nazar Singh, who expired in 1990. Respondent No.4 Manjit Kaur, the widow of Nazar Singh was 25 years of age at that time and she started residing with petitioner No.1 – Ujjagar Singh, who was hardly 15 years of age at that time. From that relationship, one child, namely, Kulvinder Singh was born, who was handicapped. Later on, in the year 2009, Manjit Kaur started living separately. Kulvinder, on the other hand, was residing with petitioner No.1- Ujjagar Singh, Ujjagar performed marriage with one Veerpal Kaur and from that wedlock, two children were born. Learned counsel further contends that Kulvinder, who was handicapped, executed a Will in favour of petitioner No.1 – Ujjagar Singh. Respondent No.4 made a complaint to the Police alleging the Will to be a forged document. Necessary inquiry was held and that complaint was found to be false. Said Manjit Kaur then filed a civil suit and again she did not get any relief. Learned counsel contends that when respondent No.4 did not get any relief either from the Civil Court or from the Police, she with the help of respondents No.5 to 7, has started threatening the petitioners.

By way of present petition, prayer is made to protect the life and liberty of petitioners, which is in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7. Petitioners made a representation dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P.4) to respondents No.2 and 3 but no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

This petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P.4) moved by the petitioners, in the light of the contends thereof and provide necessary protection to the petitioners after assessing the threat perceptions to their life and liberty.
