At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that inadvertently, Superintendent of Police, has been made party as party No.2 instead of Deputy Commissioner of Police,Panckula.

In view of the oral request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, he is directed to carry out the necessary corrections in the head note as well as the prayer clause of the petition.

The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Panchkula and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 16.09.2023 (Annexure P-5).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Sheenu Sura, Deputy Advocate

General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2– Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, District Panchkula is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed off.
