Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 for registration of FIR against respondent Nos.4 to 8 on the basis of complaint dated 25.02.2021 (P-1).

(2) In response to the notice of motion, status report by way of affidavit dated 01.12.2023 of Sh. Harjinder Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Model Town, Jalandhar, along with Annexure R-1, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side. Para 4 of the affidavit, being relevant, reads as under:-

“That it is respectfully submitted that the enquiry into the said complaint have been completed and the case FIR no.245 dated 28.11.2023 under section 420 IPC P.S. Navi Baradari had

been registered against Vijay Kumar son of Anant Ram Chadha resident of 188, Green Park, Jalandhar. The copy of the FIR is attached as Annexure R-1.”

- (3) Perusal of the above extract reveals that FIR No.245 dated 28.11.2023, under Section 420 IPC, Police Station Navi Baradari has already been registered in the matter.
- (4) As a result thereof, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter except that investigation be completed, expeditiously, in accordance with law.
- (5) Disposed off accordingly.
- (6) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
