1. This petition is filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short 'the Act') for appointment of an Arbitrator.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions submits that dispute can be resolved. The petitioner was awarded the work for installing five elevators in a hospital at Jalalabad. The elevators were installed but three were not operational. He further submits that GST/VAT invoice was asked for from the petitioner which was not supplied. The contention is that in case the lifts are made operational and GST/VAT invoice is furnished, the payment would be released.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioners would approach the respondent within three weeks from today.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that an earnest effort would be made to resolve the matter amicably.
5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed of at this stage.
