Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.538 dated 12.10.2022 registered under Sections 22(b), 27-A of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

2. The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner was named as accused on the basis of the disclosure statement made by co-accused Vinod Kumar from whom the police recovered 180 tablets of Alprazolam 0.5 mg on 12.10.2022 and the said recovery comes under non-commercial quantity.

3. On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police. Today, counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that by virtue of the aforesaid order of interim bail, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and that the petitioner is having no criminal

history.

4. State counsel on instructions from SI Rajmal has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the currency note worth ₹500/- have been recovered from possession of the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 31.10.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
