For the reasons mentioned in the application, same stands allowed.
Offence under Section 325 IPC added in the head note as well as in the prayer
clause of the petitioner. Registry is directed to carry out necessary amendments in
this regard.

CRM-M-50202-2022

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the
grant of regular bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No.0137 dated 22.09.2022,
under Sections 365, 323, 325, 506, 341, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station
Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order
dated 11.01.2023, of this Court, the petitioner has not only joined investigation

but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency. He further submits that in case the investigating agency requires the petitioner to appear, he shall make himself available without demur.

Learned State counsel on instructions affirms the factum of joining the investigation by the petitioner and cooperating with the investigation agency. He also submits that at this stage, the petitioner is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed and the order dated 11.01.2023 granting interim bail to him, is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner fails to join and cooperate with the investigation agency as and when required, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of the present anticipatory bail granted to him.
