The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 06.12.2021, passed by this Court in CRWP-11459-2021, vide which, a direction was issued to the respondents to enter in the relevant register, the petitioner's cross version, with respect to FIR, lodged at the police station concerned and thereafter, conduct a fair investigation thereinto.

As per affidavit, filed by the SHO of the Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran, it is a dispute between father and son. It is further stated that father of the petitioner, namely Nirmal Singh, has registered FIR No. 66 dated 01.09.2021, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at the aforesaid police station. It is further stated that in compliance with the aforesaid order, the Investigating Officer, in order to record the cross version, has repeatedly visited the house of the petitioner, however, neither petitioner nor any of his family members has come forward to record their

statement.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
