Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking pre-arrest bail in:-

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the wife of the deceased, Vijay Kumar. He has made a reference to the interim order dated 21.09.2023 passed by this Court, whereby petitioner’s mother, Sukhwinder Kaur, has been granted interim protection.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent.

List on 01.12.2023.

Petitioner is directed to join the investigation on 18.10.2023 at 10:00 A.M. at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana and co-operate with the Investigating Agency. In the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard with CRM-M-47716-2023.”

Today, it is informed by learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Singh, that in compliance of the order dated 06.10.2023, petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is no longer required for any investigation.

In view of the afore-said statement, order dated 06.10.2023 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
