HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer that the salary w.e.f. February, 2021 has not been released to him and that too without any valid justification.
2. Further prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner along with arrears and interest.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 17.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) upon the respondents and the same is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the Gram Panchayat-respondent No.5 has not disposed of the legal notice dated 17.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) and the same is still pending consideration, appropriate order on the legal notice will be passed within a period of eight weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
