The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.120 dated 01.08.2022 registered under Section 411 IPC, 1860 (Section 420 IPC and Section 65 of the Information and Technology Act, 2000 added later on) at Police Station Khanna City-2, District Khanna.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 16.12.2022 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of William Jeji, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana and the same is taken on record. He on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 01.11.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
