The instant petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.65, dated 11.07.2021, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation which fact has not been controverted by learned State counsel as well.

Pursuant to the above said situation, as brought to the notice of this Court today that challan stands filed on 23.02.2022 i.e. much prior to the filing of the instant petition also.

In the light of the same, this petition is not maintainable and liable to be dismissed, however, the petitioner will be at liberty to surrender and approach before the trial Court by moving an appropriate application for bail which shall be considered expeditiously in accordance with law.

However, considering the medical condition as is evident from the photographs (Annexure P-5), trial Court is requested to consider the application if any so moved on that very date in accordance with law.
