1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.203 dated 29.09.2022 under Section 20 of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short “the NDPS Act”), however, Section 29 of the NDPS Act was added later on, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala, District Patiala (Annexure P-1).

2. Vide order dated 21.11.2022, petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation. By a subsequent order, on the request made by counsel for the petitioner, petitioner was granted last opportunity to join the investigation.

3. ASI Ajaib Singh, who is the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation. Still further, he submits that the

petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

4. In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed. Order dated 21.11.2022 is made absolute, subject to the fulfillment of conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
