[1] Challenge in the instant appeal by the appellant/plaintiff is to judgment and decree dated 24.12.2013 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Bhiwani in Civil Appeal No.201 of 2011 in case titled as Pawan vs. Ram Phal and another whereby the appeal of the respondent/defendant No.1 was allowed and judgment and decree dated 09.02.2011 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Charkhi Dadri whereby the suit of the appellant was decreed partially, was reversed and civil suit was dismissed.
