Present writ petition has been filed for directing the official respondents to finalized the execution application dated 25.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) arising out of case No.18 TI dated 24.12.1998 decided on 31.01.2000 by the AC Ist Grade, Amritsar and the execution is pending for the last many years and the Sanad Taksim was prepared on dated 01.07.2010 (Annexure P-1) and there is no stay by any Court but till date the possession has not been handed over to the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated his arguments that the partition proceedings were initiated in 1998 and concluded and finally the Sanad Taksim was issued. He submits that though the respondents had filed one appeal before the Financial Commissioner but there no interim was granted in the same and thus, the partition proceedings are unnecessarily being prolonged. This Court vide order

dated 06.10.2023, summoned the Tehsildar, Majitha in the Court. In pursuance to the same, Mr. Ratan Jit, Naib Tehsildar is present in person in Court today and affirmed that the appeal is pending but there is no interim stay in the same.

Learned counsel for the State, however has submitted that notice in the appeal filed by them has already been issued for 05.01.2024.

Mr. Umesh Kumar Kanwar, Advocate has appeared and filed his memorandum of appearance on behalf of respondents No.5 to 9 today in the Court and the same is taken on record. He has stated that the appeal is pending before the Financial Commissioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Revenue Officer, before whom the execution is pending, to expedite the proceedings in the execution petition and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
