1. Case has been called twice, however, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last two dates of hearing i.e. 08.11.2023 and 27.09.2023, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
2. The prayer in the present revision petition is for setting aside the order dated 06.09.2023, passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Tract Special Court for Trial of Offences under POCSO Act, Nuh, whereby, the application filed by the petitioner for taking re-sample of the blood of the petitioner and sending the same for DNA examination, was declined.
3. As per the record, FIR was registered against the petitioner on 15.05.2020 and thereafter, medical examination of the petitioner was conducted and her blood sample was obtained for the purpose of DNA comparison. The DNA report received from the FSL is positive and the DNA profile of the petitioner was found matching with the DNA profile of the seminal stains found on the exhibit of the victim. There are no grounds for sending the second sample for examination as the petitioner has not pointed out any irregularity in the scientific examination conducted by the FSL.

4. Learned State counsel submits hat the case is fixed for trial and out of total 19 witnesses, 5 have been examined.
5. After hearing learned counsel(s) for the parties and perusing the record, I am of the opinion that no ground for interference in the impugned order dated 06.09.2023, passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Tract Special Court for Trial of Offences under POCSO Act, Nuh, is made out.
6. Accordingly, the present criminal revision petition stands dismissed.
7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
