The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of impugned orders dated 12.10.2022 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Hisar in case FIR No.0193 dated 10.3.2017 registered under section 17 of NDPS Act at Police Station, Sirsa City, District Sirsa, whereby petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Offender. It has been further directed that FIR under Section 174-A IPC be also registered against the petitioner.

This case came up for hearing on 1.11.2022, however, no one was present on behalf of the petitioner and the same was adjourned to 15.3.2023 in the interest of justice. On 15.3.2023 again no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the case was adjourned for today i.e. 16.5.2023 by granting last opportunity to the petitioner. Similar is the position today also. It appears that petitioner is not interested in pursuing this petition.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
