The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to hand over the investigation of case FIR No.0019 dated 04.02.2018 under Sections 384, 420 and 120-B of the IPC and Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station: City Raikot, Tehsil and District Ludhiana and to constitute an SIT.

It is evident from the perusal of the documents appended alongwith the present petition that the petitioner had earlier approached this Court by filing of CRM-M-6257 of 2018, wherein the similar prayer had been made. The same is extracted as under:

“Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing in the case FIR No. 19 dated 04.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) under sections 384/420/120-B of IPC and 7,13(2) of PC Act 1988, registered at Police Station, City Raikot, District, Ludhiana Rural

AND

It is further prayed that fair investigation in the case FIR No.19 dated 04.02.2018(Annexure P-1) under sections 384/420/120-B of IPC and 7, 13(2) of PC Act 1988, registered at Police Station City Raikot, District, Ludhiana Rural as well as the application/complaint of the petitioner of cheating and rape dated 30.12.2017 (AnnexureP-2) be got conducted from making SIT under the monitoring of the District and Sessions Court Ludhiana.

AND

Any other order or direction, which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may kindly be passed.”

From the perusal of the above, it is evident that the petitioner has already approached this Court by filing the above petition for seeking quashing of the abovementioned FIR as well as for conducting fair investigation by constituting an SIT under the monitoring of District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. The abovementioned CRM-M-6257 of 2018 is still pending before this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition with a prayer for seeking the same relief is not maintainable.

The petition in hand is accordingly dismissed.
