The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.210 dated 14.08.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 and 341 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 23.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Gurmit Singh Sidhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Headquarters), Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
